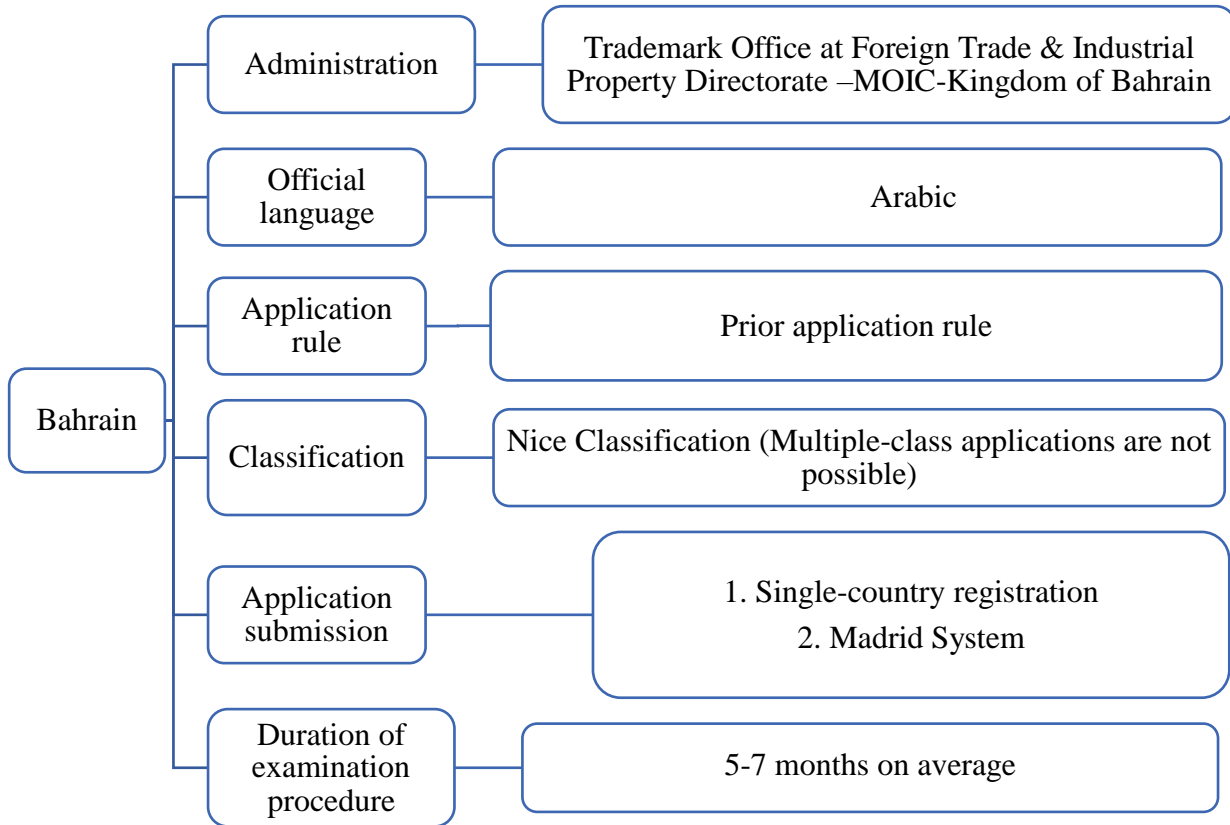


Guidance on Trademark Application in Bahrain

II. Application Documents Requested

the applicant's details (including nationality);

the list of goods and services to which the trademark will be applied;

a representation of the trademark;

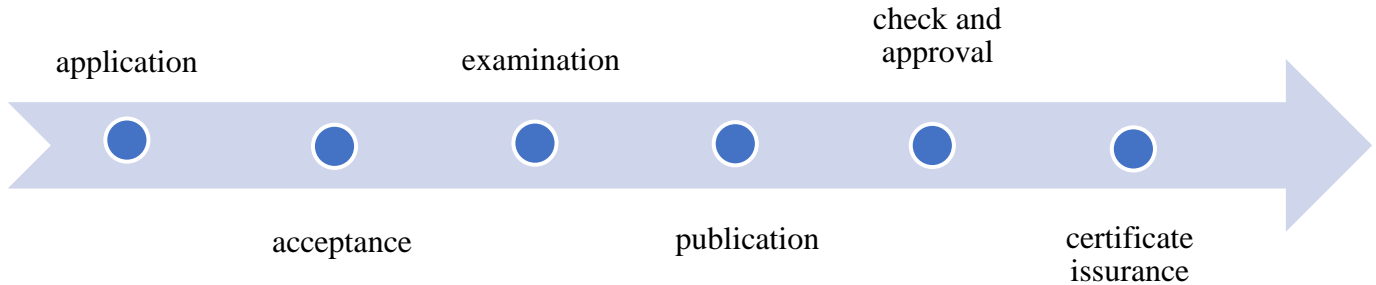
the original and a copy of the power of attorney;

certified copy of the Priority Document and its authorised translation;

a trademark application claiming conventional priority.

IV. Validity Term

- Trademarks in Bahrain are valid for a **ten-year** period from the filing date, subject to **renewal every ten years** for an unlimited number of times.
- The renewal fee is to be paid **during the year** when the registration expires.

V. Note

- The validity of a trademark registration in Bahrain may be subject to cancellation if it has not been used **within five years** from registration.
- When handling **trademark assignment**, the assignment agreement and the assignee's power of attorney must be authenticated through notarization.
