


Guidance on Trademark Application in EU

II. Application Documents Requested

Document set on application

- request for registration of a trademark;
- applicant's details;
- list of the goods and/or services;
- representation of the trade mark.
- if the application was filed not in one of the official languages, the translation in the chosen official language should be provided to the Office.



IV. Validity Term

- EU trademark is valid for 10 years from the filing date and can be renewed for successive 10-year periods an indefinite number of times.
- The proprietor of the trademark may request the renewal of the term during a six-month period prior to expiry date of trademark protection.

VI. Note

- Registration of the trademark in the European Union can be cancelled on the grounds of non-use upon a third party's request if it has not been used for 5 years from registration of a trademark.
- In case the application fulfils all formal requirements established by the legislation, and there are no absolute grounds for refusal, the application shall be published in the EU Trademark Bulletin.




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- Fast track could be used in EU Trademark examination, which saves up to 2 months and does not require additional expedited examination fees, subject to the following conditions:
 - The trade mark must be one of the following types: word, figurative, shape, or sound; If the trade mark is a figurative or shape mark, colour claims are no longer possible; If the trade mark is a figurative, shape or sound mark, the relevant valid attachments must be included;
 - All the terms in the list of goods and services must be selected from the database of terms already accepted by the EUIPO;
 - Payment must be made upfront.
- Registration of the European Union trademark (former Community Trademark) is conducted via filing one application directly with the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) and is valid in 27 European Union countries: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain and Sweden.



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
