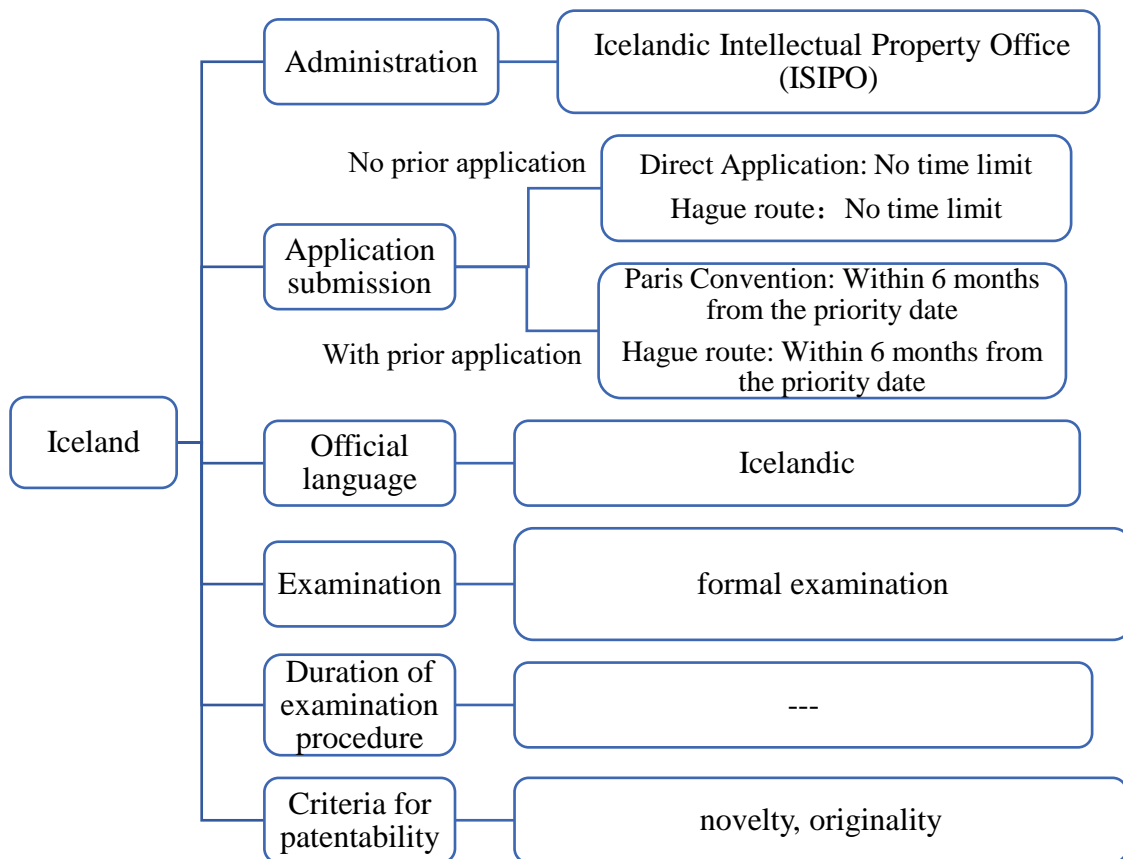

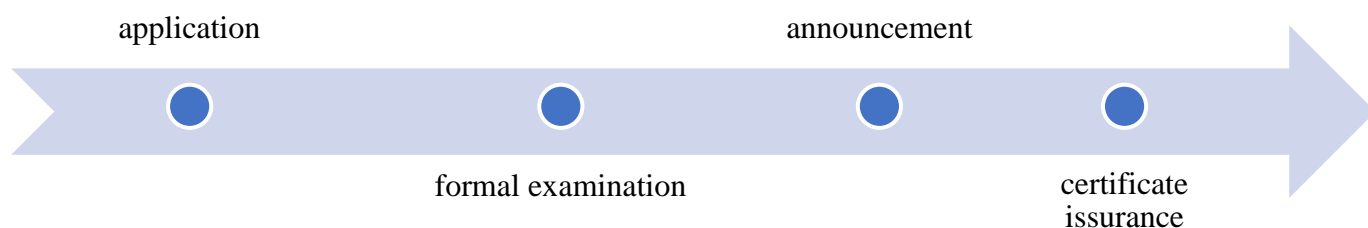
- information on the name of the applicant and specification of the product or products covered by the design
- illustrations (graphic or photographic reproductions), a model may be submitted;
- the name of the designer or designers

IV. Validity Term

- The initial term of protection for designs in Iceland is five years from the date of filing. Four renewal periods of five years each can be applied for upon expiration, with the total protection period up to 25 years.
- Renewal fees must be paid on time to maintain the validity of the design.

V. Note

- One application may include requests for the protection of more than one design. A condition for this is that the goods have the same or similar use and are classified in the same category according to the Locarno Agreement Establishing an International Classification for Industrial Designs.
