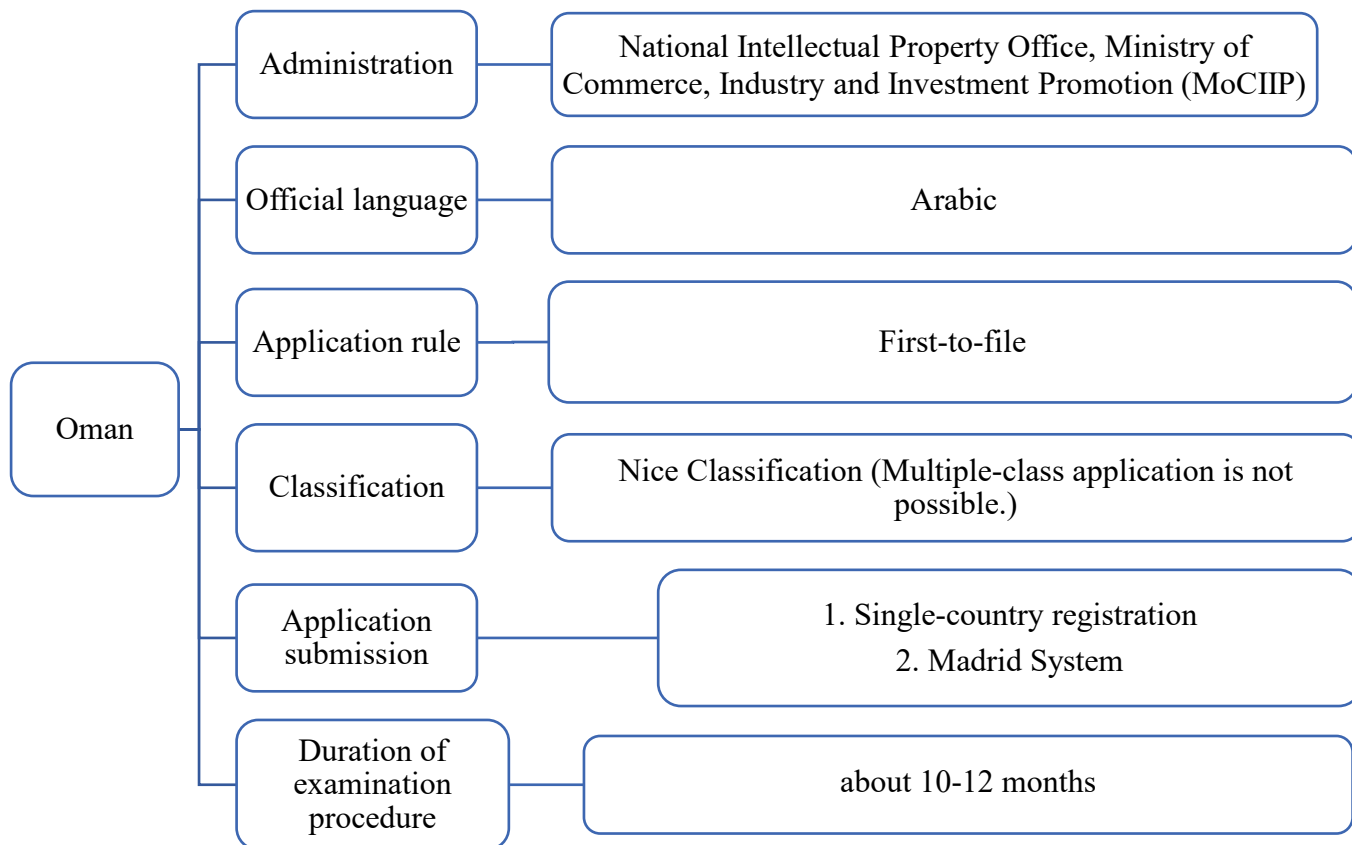

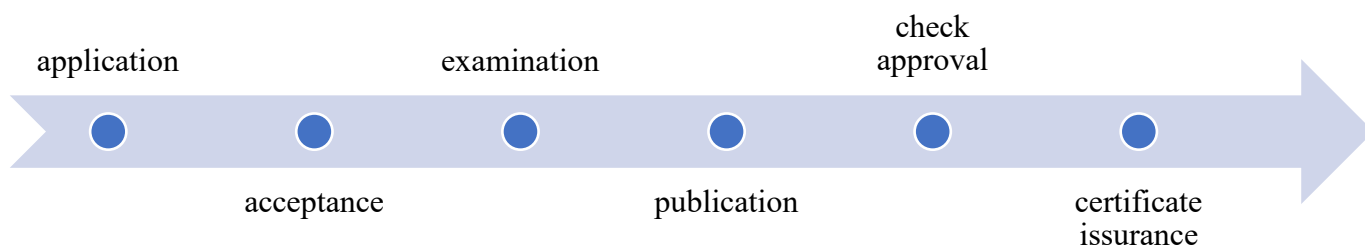

IV. Validity Term

- The term of the registration of the trademark is **ten years** starting from the date of application.
- The validity period of a trademark registration shall be renewed every time for ten years at the request of the owner filed during the last year of its validity.

V. Note

- Registration of the trademark in Oman may be cancelled if it has not been used for **consecutive three years** from the date of trademark registration.
- When conducting the transfer process, it is additionally required that the transfer agreement and the transferee's power of attorney undergo notarization and authentication.
- Oman adopts the descriptions of goods and services under the Nice Classification, excluding alcoholic beverages in Class 33 and Class 32, as well as pork products in Class 29.
