



IV. Validity Term

- A registered trade mark shall be valid for a period of ten years from the date of filing the application for registration of that trade mark.

V. Note

- A person affected by a registered trade mark may apply to the Registrar, in a prescribed manner and form on payment of a prescribed fee, for the removal of that trade mark from the Register in respect of any of the good or service for which that trademark is registered on the ground that the trade mark has not been used by a proprietor or licensee for a **continuous period of five years or more**.
